Ports' Safety Preparedness - Submission of ships' plans
safety preparedness

In view of recent events of fires on ships and incidents involving hazardous materials, safety procedures should be refreshed in order to protect the safety of ports and its preparedness .

All ships bound to Israeli Ports are requested to send, directly or through their agents, a copy in electronic PDF format of the following ship's plans:

1. Fire control & Safety Plan
2. General Arrangement Plan
3. Capacity Plan

Ships' agents are requested to ensure that all ships will forward the plans before departure. Every ship is required to submit the above plans once only.

If plans have already been submitted as required, the ship will state so in the 100 miles IMOT Report.

In cases when ships do not possess the plans in electronic format, the master must submit a statement to that effect, and is required to do so upon the next call to Israeli port.

Effective as from 1st January 2016.
